**1. REGISTER TO VOTE OR MAKE UPDATES TO YOUR REGISTRATION AT MYVOTE.WI.GOV.**

MyVote.wi.gov is easy to use

Online registration requires your Wisconsin driver license or state ID number. If you have not updated your address yet with the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), you can complete the update online during the registration process.

Online registration (MyVote.wi.gov) ends three weeks before Election Day. You may still register in person in the Clerk's office during absentee voting or at your polling place on Election Day.

**2. VOTE ON ELECTION DAY**

VOTE on Tuesday, November 6, 2018

Bring your Wisconsin driver license or state ID with you to meet the voting photo ID requirement. The address on your ID or license does not need to be current.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- If you do not have a Wisconsin driver license or ID, you can get one for free at any DMV location. Call 844-588-1069.
- For information about registering to vote by mail or on Election Day, call 414-645-1530.
- Other forms of photo ID can be used to meet the photo ID requirement.

## The 'Dark Store' Referendum

The 'Dark Store' Referendum will be on the ballot November 6th here in the Village to give you, the residents, an opportunity to send a message to the legislature in Madison whether or not you want them to take action on a measure to close a loophole in current state law that allows retailers to challenge their property tax assessments based on what a vacant building in another area would be assessed.

When big box retailers and other commercial and manufacturing properties try to avoid paying their fair share of taxes by exploiting the "dark store loophole" or the "Walgreens loophole"—which together are known as the Dark Store Loopholes—it results in property tax increases for homeowners and small businesses.

Homeowners in Wisconsin already pay a radically disproportionate 68% share of the property taxes in the state, and as more and more big box retailers exploit the Dark Store Loopholes, that number will grow even more. Additionally, the affected communities must expend additional resources to respond to these challenges including, in many cases, court costs and legal fees. These are resources that could be better spent improving and maintaining the community.

**NOTICE OF REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at an election to be held in the Village of West Milwaukee on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, the following question will be submitted to a vote of the people:

Should the state legislature protect residential property taxpayers by preventing commercial and manufacturing property owners from using tax loopholes that shift an ever-increasing tax burden to homeowners who already pay 68% of the statewide property tax levy by enacting legislation that: 1) prohibits using closed, vacant (dark) properties as comparable properties for determining the assessed value of open, occupied, and fully operational properties; and 2) overturns the 2008 Wisconsin Supreme Court decision in *Walgreens v. City of Madison*, which is being interpreted by the courts as requiring municipalities to assess many leased commercial properties at a substantial discount, often 50% below the actual sale prices of such properties?

**EXPLANATORY LANGUAGE AND EFFECT OF VOTE**

The referendum election ballot will ask the Village of West Milwaukee electors to vote “yes” or “no” on the advisory referendum question as set forth above.

A “yes” vote means you are in favor of the State Legislature enacting state wide legislation to overturn the 2008 Supreme Court case, *Walgreens Co. v. City of Madison* and to address the “Dark Store” tax strategy, thereby requiring larger commercial (“big box”) properties to pay the accurate assessed value of the property without requiring those tax burdens to be disproportionately shifted to small local businesses and residential property owners.

A “no” vote means you do not want the State Legislature to take action to overturn the 2008 Supreme Court Case, *Walgreens Co. v. City of Madison* and/or to address the “Dark Store” tax strategy, which allow larger commercial (“big box”) properties to potentially achieve lower tax burdens by comparing their retail space to vacant or abandoned retail spaces from different market segments, thereby passing those tax burdens on to small local businesses and residential property owners and/or requiring cuts to municipal services.

# Registration and Voting



## WHEN SHOULD I REGISTER OR UPDATE MY VOTER REGISTRATION?

YOU WILL NEED TO REGISTER TO VOTE OR UPDATE YOUR REGISTRATION IF YOU:

- Have not previously registered to vote in Wisconsin
- Have had any change to your address since last voting
- Have had a name change since last voting
- Have not voted in over four years

To check or confirm your voter registration status, go to [MyVote.wi.gov](http://MyVote.wi.gov).



## WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS TO REGISTER TO VOTE?

- US Citizen
  - 18 Years of age or older on Election Day
  - A resident of Wisconsin and have lived at your current address at least 10 days before the next election
  - Not currently serving a sentence, including probation, parole or extended supervision, for a felony conviction
- Note: Misdemeanor convictions do not affect voting rights
- Not otherwise disqualified from voting

## WHAT DOCUMENTS DO I NEED TO REGISTER TO VOTE?

### ONLINE REGISTRATION:

If you have a Wisconsin drivers license or Wisconsin state identification card, no other documentation is necessary.

If the address on your license or ID is not current, you may update it on the Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) website when completing the voter registration process.

You may register to vote online up to 20 days before each election.

### ALL OTHER REGISTRATION METHODS

If you are registering by mail or in-person (including Election Day), you are required to provide a proof of residence document that includes your name and current address.

Common proof of residence documents include:

- A WI Drivers License or State ID
- A cell phone or utility bill
- A bank statement or paycheck
- Any documentation (a letter, for example) issued to you by a government agency or public school

### ONCE I AM REGISTERED, WHAT TYPE OF ID DO I NEED TO VOTE?

In order to cast a ballot, voters in Wisconsin must present acceptable photo identification.

The address on the photo ID does not need to be current. Out of state licenses and identification cards are not allowed under Wisconsin state law.

The following photo IDs are most commonly presented documents:

- A Wisconsin Driver License, even if driving privileges are revoked or suspended.
- A Wisconsin Identification Card issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles (available for free)
- A Military or Veteran ID
- A U.S. Passport book or card

### HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR ELECTION DAY?

- Confirm your polling place and review the contests/candidates on your sample ballot at [www.westmilwaukee.org](http://www.westmilwaukee.org).
- Polling locations are open on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Check your schedule for any conflicts and consider voting absentee ballot by mail.
- Bring your photo ID!





## HOW DO I VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT?

**What is absentee voting?** Absentee voting is casting your vote before Election Day, either through the mail or in person in the Clerk's office.

**Who can vote absentee?** Any registered voter can vote absentee in Wisconsin – no reason is necessary.

**Do I need a photo ID?** Yes. Unless you are voting through the mail and certify that you are indefinitely confined, are a military or permanent overseas voter, you must present photo ID to vote absentee.

**By Mail:** Request to vote through the mail by going to [MyVote.wi.gov](http://MyVote.wi.gov) or call (414) 645-1530 to be mailed an application.

**Will My Ballot Be Counted?** Yes. We process all absentee ballots on Election day at the Polls. If your ballot is received by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, it is processed and included with the final election results.

## Real Estate and Personal Property Tax Payments

Each year the tax bills are mailed out in December. To have your 2018 taxes marked paid in 2018, they must be received in our office on or before December 28, 2018. Make sure you are aware of the holidays that we are closed for business, so as to alleviate any problems when paying your taxes.

Please write your parcel number on the memo part of your check stub.

Make sure your check is made out to the Village of West Milwaukee. If it is made out to another municipality, you will have to return it and have a new check made out to replace it. Also, if the check is made out to you the homeowner and the Village, you must sign the back of the check.

## Personal Property Taxes

The Village must be notified of any and all changes to businesses. We must be notified if a business moves out so we can change the name and address of the property that needs to receive the PP bills and the statement of personal property form.

In January, the assessor will send out the statement of personal property form for each business to report their amount of PP. This must be completed and returned to the assessor's office by March 1st of each year. If this is not reported and we are not notified of any changes, the assessor will figure the taxes accordingly based on the prior year's taxes and you will continue to receive PP tax bills.

## TAX REFUNDS

The Village will not issue immediate refunds for overpayments of tax bills in excess of \$100.00. Refund checks will be issued with the next accounts payable run. There is a minimum fifteen (15) day waiting period for a refund check over \$100.00, to make sure your escrow check clears the bank. Should you wish to have a refund in a more expedient manner, you may request that your financial institute issue one check for the actual amount due for taxes and another check to you for the remaining balance. Immediate refunds of amounts less than \$100.00 will only be given if the funds are available. Any refunds under \$10.00 will have to be picked up in person.
