Dear Resident and/or Property Owner,

This letter is sent to notify and inform you that S. 49th Street (National Ave to Greenfield Ave), 48th/49th Street Alley and the 45th Street Alley are scheduled for resurfacing as part of the Village's Paving Program. Please be aware that temporary no parking signs will be going up on S. 49th Street so please plan on parking on neighboring streets. S. 49th Street will remain open to travel at all times, except for when utility work is occurring, concrete base patching occurs, and during paving operations. Access to garages on alleys will remain open during construction except for when base patching is occurring, and during paving operations. The schedule for the work associated with this project can be seen on the Village's website (<https://www.westmilwaukee.org>). The contractor will inform residents if there will be a temporary disruption of access. The work on S. 49th street includes minor storm sewer and sanitary sewer repairs, removing and replacing sections of curb, removing and replacing select driveways, removing and replacing the asphalt pavement, installation of new street lighting and the installation of two speed humps. The work in the alleys includes the removal and replacement of the asphalt surface and concrete base repairs. There are no costs or assessments to the property owners. Work is scheduled to begin the end of **September 2026**. Once work begins in your area, it should take approximately **two months** to complete. This schedule may be affected due to weather and other conditions.

The Village will have an onsite representative (inspector) observing the contractor's work. This oversight is conducted by a contracted firm (raSmith, Inc.). At the time of construction feel free to contact this person with your questions or concerns.

Please take note of the following conditions, including but not limited to:

- Obstructions within Public Right of Way (interference with road maintenance)
 - Landscaping
 - Decorative stone, brick, and timber removed shall not be reinstalled.
 - Owner is responsible to remove and/or salvage.
 - Plantings/Vegetation
 - Removed and shall not be reinstalled.
 - Owner is responsible to remove and or salvage.
